ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Pre-Show:

- a. Attend production meetings.
- b. Responsible for presenting the lighting budget request to the Technical Director or Producer.
- c. Recruit and supervise the crew for hanging the instruments.

2. Production/Rehearsals:

- a. Prepare scene by scene lighting design and review with Director for approval.
- b. Staying within the approved budget, procure the necessary materials and equipment.
- c. Submit bills to the Technical Director for approval and submission to Treasurer and/or Producer for payment.
- d. Coordinate the use of the stage with the Technical Director.
- e. Must hang all lighting equipment prior to rehearsal start times.
- f. Recruit and supervise the crew for rehearsal and show execution.
- g. Work out cues with the Director and Stage Manager.

3. Performances:

- a. Check that all instruments are properly running before each show in sufficient time for problem resolution before the house opens.
- b. Coordinate the start of the show with the Stage Manager and House Manager.
- c. Supervise lighting cue execution of the performance.

4. Post Production:

a. Assists with strike on closing night and attends closing night party.

QUALIFICATIONS

To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential duty satisfactorily. The requirements listed below are representative of the knowledge, skill, and/or ability required. - Must be available January through early March for rehearsals which will be scheduled a minimum of two
 nights per week from approximately 7:00 pm 10:00 pm. Time commitment may increase and include
 weekends two weeks prior to opening night.
- Must be available to attend at least 1 rehearsal before tech week and then attend all tech/dress rehearsals.
- Must have previous lighting experience.
- Must have thoroughly read the script with particular attention to lighting requirements.
- Must be a strong team player.
